

LEarly warning systems enable a population to be adequately prepared for the occurrence of a disaster and contribute to significantly minimising the impact of natural hazards (hurricanes, floods, droughts, volcanic eruptions, earthquakes, landslides, snow avalanches...), or manmade hazards on people's lives.

The Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) aims to "substantially increase people's availability and access to multi-hazard early warning systems and disaster risk information and assessment by 2030". In addition, it is imperative to promote a shift from a "response" to an "early action" mindset, and to strengthen models for more powerful early action based on reliable forecasts. It will also be indispensable for EWS to be people-centred, empowering tem and their communities in the process of taking action in the event of disasters.
